

HOUSE KEEPING PARKING – ZIG ZAG LINES

As a school, we are very lucky to have a car park that parents may use, if they come to school by car. The car park will be busy during drop off and collection times. Please be patient while spaces become available and avoid parking on the zig zag lines outside school so that we can keep the children as safe as we can. The lanes in the village are very narrow and quickly become blocked if people park in them.

All children in Apsemore, Barnhill and Boxwell classes are provided with a piece of fruit for their morning snack. This is part of the government's fruit for school initiative.
